SUBJECT: Call for Expression of Interest for Doctoral Studies – Period March 2026

Following the decision of the School Assembly (Meeting of 15-07-2025), interested candidates for doctoral studies at the School of Civil Engineering are invited to submit an application to the Secretariat, in accordance with the following terms.

Application period: from the 1st to the 31st of March 2026

Submission method: Completion and submission of the application form (see relevant link) electronically to ekponisi_diatrivis@civil.ntua.gr, with the required supporting documents attached. Applicants are encouraged to collaborate with the proposed supervising Professors when completing the application form.

Regulatory framework: Law 4957/2022 and the Doctoral Studies Regulation (DSR) of the National Technical University of Athens (see relevant link).

Eligibility to apply for the preparation of a Doctoral Dissertation is granted to:

- a) Graduates of four-year University Schools corresponding to two hundred forty (240) ECTS credits, who also hold a Master's Degree (MSc) in the same or a related field to the proposed Doctoral Dissertation, corresponding to at least sixty (60) ECTS credits. It is noted that the relevance requirement applies both to the first degree (four-year duration) and to the Master's Degree.
- b) Graduates (Diploma holders) of NTUA and Polytechnic Schools with a minimum of five years of study, including a diploma thesis, corresponding to three hundred (300) ECTS credits, who hold an integrated and indivisible postgraduate-level degree (integrated master).

Selection process: As defined in the DSR.

Maximum number of doctoral candidates to be admitted: 40
